## Frequently Asked Questions


How do I participate? Simply fill out the form attached to this brochure and send it to MCRC with your initial contribution. To help in other ways, contact the camp office.

# What are Monroe Covenant Keepers?

Monroe Covenant Keepers or "MC Keepers" for short, are churches and individuals who commit to supporting Monroe Camp and Retreat Center by praying regularly for the center's ministry and providing support with talents and financial gifts.
