We've run out of space for campers, and its finally time to renovate (enclose) Cabins 3 & 4 that are still in their original rustic 1954 condition.

We aim to expand our water toys at Camp Monroe by adding new slides and inflatable structures. Our goal is to have these ready by next summer for a vibrant experience. Support for this initiative is welcomed, as every contribution helps bring joy and laughter to our campers' summer.
